An innovation is something new.

For example: an invention.

Small museums are very important.

But often **only a few** people know about small museums.

Or people **cannot** visit small museums.

Small museums are often far away from the cities.

Then the way is too far for many people.

Or the way is too difficult for many people.

The SMART Project wants to make visiting small museums easier for all.

So the SMART Project uses many new technologies.

Technology means: using new things.

Visiting small museums is easier with the new technologies.

And many more people get to know small museums.

For example:

- People can visit the museums of the SMART Project and say:
 - I want to read the information directly in the museum.
 - Or I want to listen to the information with a head·phone.
 - Or I want to watch videos.
- Some people **cannot** go to a small museum.

Sometimes the museum is far away.

Then these people can visit this small museum virtually.

Virtual means:

People can visit the museum by using a computer or tablet.

The visitors can see all objects of the museum on the computer or on the tablet.

So the visitors feel like being inside the museum.

And people **do not** have to go to the museum.
